Duration: 3 years

Eligibility Criteria:

- 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre

B.SC Nursing

Duration: 4 years

Eligibility Criteria:

BSc Nursing is catered in two segments, which are BSc Basic and BSc Post Basic. The eligibility criteria for BSc Nursing is a 10+2 or equivalent examination completion certificate from Science stream with PCB and English as compulsory subjects.

For BSc Nursing Post Basic, the basic criteria are the same as BSc Nursing eligibility criteria. Apart from it, for BSc Nursing Post Basic, candidates need to acquire a General Nursing Midwifery (GNM) certificate and register her/himself from State Nurses Registration Council as Registered Nurse Registered Midwife (RNRM).

ANTI RAGGING MEASURES

As per direction of the Honorable Supreme Court of India, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside the campus and authorities are determined not to allow any form of ragging. Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or instigates ragging within or outside SWADHIN NURSING INSTITUTE shall have an FIR lodged against him/her and he/she will be suspended or rusticated from the Institute and shall also be liable to be fined which may extend to Rs.10,000/-. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging, admission can be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the Institute. The punishment may also include suspension from attending the classes, withholding/withdrawing fellowship/ scholarship and other financial benefits or withholding the result.
