Facility of Scholarship for Students

Eligibility Criteria

- A. Duration of course : 3 years
- B. Only Male students can apply.
- C. Educational qualification: Higher Secondary (10+2) from WBCHSE or equivalent.
- D. Minimum age: 17 years.
- E. Students must be resident of west Bengal (atleast 5 years continuously)
- F. Students should be medically fit.

Courses Offered

Genex Nursing Institute, Mulkathi, Raina-1, Purba Burdwan is offering General Nursing and Midwifery or GNM program, is a three years recognised course by Indian Nursing Council (I.N.C.) and West Bengal Nursing Council (W.B.N.C.) for male students with a intake capacity of 60. It is a compulsory residential course. U.G., P. G. nursing programs are coming in near future.

Admission process

As per the norms of West Bengal Govt. for the academic session 2023-26, students will be admitted as per the result of common entrance test ANM & GNM 2021 conducted by WBJEED. The prospectus may be collected from the institution.

Facility of Practical class

Well equipped demonstration lab of the institution are used for the practical class. Besides that our students are sent to the different eminent hospitals of West Bengal for their clinical experience throughout the year.

Our clinics accommodate presentation facilities and clinical conferences to link theory and practice. We create ample opportunities to let our students apply what is taught in the class room.

RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL

- Every student admitted to the Nursing course shall have to follow rules and regulations of the Lakshmi Nursing Institute.
- The Institute shall have the right to cancel the admission or expel the student at any time if she is found guilty of suppression of information or supply of false information.
- The marksheet of H.S Exam will be verified from the concern board or council.
- The students are responsible to pay all the fees due in time.
- All decisions taken by the management are final and students are bound to follow. Management is free to change the rules and regulations at any time depending upon the circumstances.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the institute and hospital property and help in maintaining the same. They should not write on the black board, scribble on tables, chairs, walls etc.
- Students are not allowed to come directly to the Principal's /management's office. They can come only with the permission of the class in charge.
- If the students have any problem, they should inform the class representative and he will intimate it to the class coordinators. If the problem is not solved at the class coordinator's level, then it will be presented to the Principal. Exceptions are allowed only if the problem is utmost urgent/serious.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- A student is not allowed to receive gift of any sort at any time from the patients of the hospital or their relatives.
- Regular and punctual attendance in all class activities is a must.
- Prior written permission from Principal through class coordinator is required for any absenteeism.
- Students have to participate in all college activities like clinical meetings, conferences, guest lectures, seminars, sports, cultural activities etc.
- Students will have to open their own bank account with net banking facilities for online transactions.
- For any kind of misbehaviour with staff or creating disturbances in classroom and in the institute premises the concerned student will be expelled from the institute.
- If any student is found to use of liquor or narcotics on hospital duty or in institute premises or is found indulging in any antisocial, criminal activities, He will be expelled from the institution.
- Possession of weapons, explosive and other objectionable material in institute/ hostel will result in being expelled from the institution.
- Taking active part in politics will result in being expelled from the institution.
- Coming on hospital duty or entering the institute premises in a un-presentable appearance will be liable to punishment.
- Ragging is a punishable offense. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the institute campus. Any student/students involved in such activities will be immediately expelled from the institution. Both junior and senior students are required to maintain cordial relationship with each other and a disciplined atmosphere in the institute.
- Students are required to carry their identity cards during college hours, clinical and whenever they are going out and must be produced whenever it is asked by the concerned authority.
- Students are required to co-operate in keeping campus neat, clean and green.

CLASS RULES

- Students should maintain silence in the classes, library, reading room and in the corridors.
- Students are required to be punctual at class as well as in clinical area. They are not allowed to miss class or clinical area without genuine reason and prior permission.
- Students must be in recommended uniform in the clinics, community and classrooms.
- No student shall be allowed to appear in the annual examination of the concerned subject if his attendance for theory class for the subject fall short of 80% of the total sessions.
- No student shall be allowed to appear in the annual examination of the concerned subject if his clinical attendance fall short of 100% of the total sessions. Hence, make up duty is compulsory for any absence in clinical area.
- Students should be present in the institute on the last and first working days before and after the vacations.
- Vacations are scheduled as per WBNC calender.
- Use of cell phone by students is strictly prohibited in class rooms, hospital and community health postings.
- In case of illness, permission shall have to be obtained from the principal to remain absent from studies.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Visitors are not allowed during clinical & class hours. In case of emergency, parent/ local guardian may communicate with the Principal or institute authority.
- Any student who damages the reputation of the college in any way is liable to be expelled. If any student discontinues the course, he shall clear all dues for the remaining duration of the course.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards in behavior both inside and outside the college, hospital, hostel and community premises.
- Each student is responsible for the proper handling and safe custody of any apparatus or equipment that she may be using in different nursing labs. Misuse or negligence will result in replacement of the particular apparatus or equipment by the candidate. Any willful damage done to the property of the institute and hospital will be treated as breach of discipline.

LIBRARY

- All books are to be used with care in library. If a book while under issue to anyone be damaged or lost, the student in whose name the book is issued, will be held responsible for the cost of repair to the satisfaction of the library committee or replacement if the damage cannot be satisfactorily made good or if the book is lost. The term "book" also includes pamphlet, magazine, journal, etc.

HOSTEL

- Accommodation at hostel is mandatory as per regulation of WBNC.
 - Allotment of hostel room will be at the sole discretion of the institution.
 - Rooms should be kept clean and tidy. Students are fully responsible for any loss /damage of furniture / fixtures allotted to them.
 - Proper locks should be used for cupboards and boxes. Expensive items are not permitted in the rooms and the institution shall not be responsible for any theft / loss or damage of students' personal belongings in any manner whatsoever.
 - Wastage of water, electricity or any other resources will lead to disciplinary action.
 - Students have to maintain discipline and decorum in the hostel complex
 - No electrical appliances or inflammable items will be allowed in hostel room.
 - Use of mobile phone is restricted to the time as may be fixed by the institute.
 - Students should have their food in dining hall only.
 - Visitors are allowed to visit the student on holidays and Sundays between 10 am to 6 pm after taking prior per mission. Visitors are not permitted to visit the student's room.
 - Students will be given out pass on Wednesdays from 5.30 pm to 7 pm and Sundays & Holidays from 9am to 7 pm. Night pass will be issued twice a month on weekends with prior permission from Class Coordinator and Warden. Students should return from night pass within 7 pm on the scheduled date. If any incident happens to the student while on out pass/ night pass/ without permission, the institute will not be liable. In case of any emergency, parents/ local guardian may visit student
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after taking permission from class coordinator. Students should not leave the hostel without permission and proper documentation for leaving and returning to hostel is mandatory.

- Ragging is a criminal offense. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the hostel. Any student/ students involved in such activities will be immediately expelled from the institution. Both junior and senior students are required to maintain cordial relationship with each other and a disciplined atmosphere in the institute.
- In case of sickness, students should report to the Warden/ Class Coordinator/ Principal. Any student suffering from any infectious disease will be sent back immediately to his home.
- Hostel articles must be returned at the time of final clearance from the hostel. Clearance will be given after complete handover is given to the warden.
- Students should maintain cordial relation with roommates and not cause any inconvenience to them. Students should report any unusual behaviour or activities of any roommate to the class coordinator.
